The intervention:

Since a few years, yellow boxes have been placed in classrooms to facilitate the recycling of paper. It's useful to remind everybody of their right use.

They reminded everybody the purpose of those boxes .
And though it might seem a little effort individually,
it represented a large amount of paper in the whole school.

Why those boxes ?

- *To put : only sheets of paper which have not been stained or crumpled. (to facilitate their recycling), cartons, magazines, newspapers ...*
- *Not to put : plastic packaging or covering (those around newspapers for ex.), not for paper handkerchiefs, not for used school supplies for example :no pens, no markers, staples, ink cartridges, or batteries.*
